



## **Badminton – REGULATIONS**

**After the sports conferences on December 1, 2019, adjustments will be made.**

In the 2020 FISEC games, the competitors of the Badminton events must be born in 2003, 2004 or 2005.

### **Article 1**

#### **Disciplines**

The following competitions are organised for both boys and girls :

- teams competition
- singles
- doubles
- mixed double

### **Article 2**

Each player can take part in 4 events (single, double, mixed, team).

### **Article 3**

Each country may register max. 3 Teams.

Every Team:

- maximum 3 girls, minimum 2 girls
- maximum 3 boys, minimum 2 boys

### **Article 4**

Each country may register pro Team:

- 1 singles boys
- 1 singles girls
- 1 double boys
- 1 double girls
- 1 mixed (boy and girl)

### **Article 5**

#### **System of play**

- Simple knockout system in individual competition
- Group system with subsequent knockout system in the team competition

## **Article 6**

The rules of the Badminton World Federation (BWF) are applied.

## **Article 7**

### **Shuttles:**

DBV (German Badminton Association) approved feather shuttlecocks.

A maximum of three shuttlecocks are provided per game.

## **Article 8**

### **Referees and Score:**

No referees are appointed. The players agree among themselves.

In case of doubt the tournament referee can be called.

The Winner(s) of a game serves the scoreboard on the previously played field.

## **Article 8**

### **Clothing regulations**

Playing is only allowed in clothing listed below:

1. polo shirt, T-shirt or tank top;
2. shorts (also athletics shorts) or skirt;
3. cyclists shorts, if worn under short or skirt;
4. sports footwear and sports socks;
5. hair ribbon and/or wristband.
