



TENNIS

After the sports conferences on December 1, 2019, adjustments will be made.

Article 1

The following competitions will be held both for boys and girls. Born in 2003, 2004, 2005.

- Singles
- Girls Doubles and Boys Doubles

Article 2

Each player can take part in a maximum of 2 competitions .

Article 3

Each Country may register:

- 4 girls
- 4 boys
- several boys doubles
- several girls doubles

Article 4

For all the competitions (girls and boys) each delegation is to submit the list of players or teams in descending seeded order and put down on the nominative inscription form.

Article 5

Depending on the number of competitors, the following playing schedule is applied :

2 to 5 players or doubles: one group

6 to 8 players or doubles: two groups, crossed semi-finals - final and a match to determine the 3rd and 4th places.

9 to 11 players or doubles: three groups and semi-finals for the first of each group and the second best etc....

12 to 16 layers or doubles: four groups, then quarter finals for the first and second of each group etc....

17 to 19 players or doubles: five groups, then quarter finals for the first in each group and three best seconds etc.....

20 to 21 players or doubles: six groups, then quarter finals for the first of each group and the two best seconds etc....

22 to 23 players or doubles: seven groups, then quarter finals for the first of each group and the best second etc....

24 to 32 players or doubles: eight groups, then quarter finals for the winners of each group etc.....

More than 32 players or doubles: eight groups, then 1/8 finals for the first and second in each group etc.....

Article 6

All matches (singles and doubles) are played on a best of two sets basis. Tie break in all sets at 6/6. (Tie-Break-System as ITF-regulation 5b).
At set match after two played sets, the third set is played as a match tie break to ten .

Article 7

The ranking in all groups is based on the number of victories obtained. If two or more players or doubles have the same number of wins, the first difference is the difference between the games. If there is a tie here as well, the lot decides.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

Article 8

The inscriptions are beforehand based on the possibilities (number of courts available) of the organising country

Tennis balls must conform to the ITF regulations and are supplied by the organising country.

Article 9

Except for the above regulations, the ITF regulations are to be applied.
